## Clothing

- Shorts
- T-shirts/modest tank tops
- Clothes/shoes to get dirty
- Dark clothing for night games
- Underwear
- Pajamas
- Pants/Jeans
- Jacket, fleece, or sweatshirt
- Rain gear
- Bathing suit (*modest one-piece for girls*)

## Toiletries

- Tooth brush/tooth paste
- Soap
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Brush/Comb
- Hair accessories
- Deodorant

## Footwear

- Tennis shoes
- Flip-flops
- Shower shoes

## Items to leave at home

- Cell phones
- Video players
- mp3 players
- Pocket knives, paintball markers, air soft guns, lighters, etc.
- We discourage you from bringing valuable personal items to camp as EIBC will not be held responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items

## Things to keep in mind when packing

For girls, tankinis are acceptable if the top significantly overlaps the bottom

For all campers, clothing must be modest, not low-cut or too tight. Modesty is at the discretion of your camper's counselor. If you are not sure about a clothing selection, then leave it home.

## Linens
